Pokémon Go stops could lead kids to dangerous places

With the popular game Pokémon Go, kids can interact with virtual game components in real-life locations. Some features of the game can present serious dangers for children using the app and interacting with other gamers. "PokéStops" – locations in which players can collect Pokémon – can be anywhere, and recently, one was reported to be at the entrance of a rehabilitation center that housed sex offenders. Parents should be aware of the game's features and monitor children's use to ensure that any Pokémon collecting is done safely.
