- **Onsite: Oct. 18 (Fri) 6pm-9pm & Oct. 19 (Sat) 9am-4pm**
- Online: Oct. 20-26, Oct. 27-Nov. 2

Module 3:

- Online: Nov. 3-9, Nov. 10-16
- **Onsite: Nov. 22 (Fri) 6pm-9pm & Nov. 23 (Sat) 9am-4pm**
